1. **NO OBJECTS OF ANY KIND MAY BE DISTRIBUTED OR THROWN TO THE PARADE SPECTATORS FROM ANY PARADE UNIT. THIS IS A SAFETY HAZARD, AND VIOLATORS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE ROUTE.**
2. All mechanical equipment must be in sound working condition and carry a portable emergency fire extinguisher. Self-propelled floats must be equipped with a tow bar or chain, mounted at the front of the float.
3. **A short (60-second) drill may be performed periodically throughout the parade as long as a fifty (50)- foot spacing is maintained between entries. This will be strictly enforced.**
4. Parade officials will be stationed along the parade route. They will be clearly identified (orange vests) and their authority must be respected.
5. All entries must complete the parade route. Disbanding of your unit shall not occur prior to the Lake Blvd. light at MacGregor School. Units disbanding early shall be disqualified from competition.
6. All fees for the Parade have been waved at this time. Note, this is a non-competitive parade (with the exception of the Bands)
7. All sound-equipped entries must specify on their parade application the type of equipment being used.
8. **Aerial Stunts: Our liability insurance prohibits stunts. No aerial stunts will be permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, Cheerleading/Yell Leaders and Gymnastics groups doing lifts, pyramids and/or throwing members in the air. You will be disqualified from the Parade if an Official or Judge sees aerial stunts performed. This is in accordance with the American Associations of Cheerleading Coaches & Advisors Safety Manual."**
9. **Riders on Open Vehicles, Trailers & Floats: All Riders on any moving vehicle (including truck beds, trailers and floats) must be either safely seated, or they must be holding a Safety Rail or Safety T-Bar (either of which is firmly attached to the frame of the vehicle). Children under the age of 7 MUST be seated. Children between 7 and 13 must be seated, or be harnessed to the Safety Rail or Safety T-Bar**
10. Parade entries shall have visual identification (e.g. street banner, vehicle banners, etc.) Signage must conform to the specifications of the parade organizing committee. Any questions pertaining to banners/signs should be directed to the parade chair.
11. Equestrian entrants must provide their own means of transporting trailers to the disband area located behind MacGregor School at the end of the parade. **Trailers MUST follow the designated Parade Shuttle from Staging to MacGregor School prior to the parade. The Shuttle will then transport the riders back to Staging Area to prepare for the parade step-off.**
12. Announcer stands will be located on the right side of the line of march.
13. Security arrangements for entries are the responsibility of the participants. Neither the Newark Days Parade Committee nor its agents are responsible or liable for your entry. Note that security is provided along the parade route by our local Police Department.
14. Any person under the age of 7 must be in a vehicle, on a float or accompanied by an adult at all times.
15. The Newark Days Celebration, Inc. and the Parade Committee are not responsible for false statements made by the entrant.
16. Automobiles are required to have proof of insurance.
17. The End of the Parade is located at Lake Street/MacGregor School. Do not leave parade route prior to this location unless previously approved and/or directed by Parade Officials.
