long.

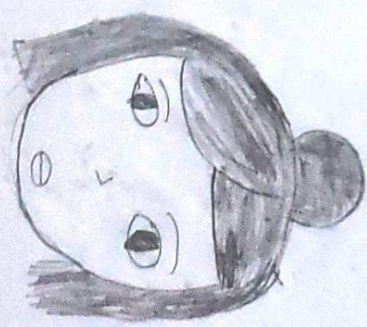
