We are honored to have been one of the sub-counties in Kenya to have received your donations.

However we request that you consider all our public day schools in the provision of the lunch programme. All the children who go to these schools are from very poor backgrounds which is purely a slum area, where a good number of children have one meal per day while also another group may not afford a meal in a couple of days.

Amongst this children are also those on medications especially HIV positive and other chronic diseases which warrant taking a meal before to counteract the effects of medications.

Lack of lunch programs in our public schools has significantly resulted in a low enrolment. This means that some children are out of school either assisting parents earn money for their families or are too hungry to attend schools. The proof of this is the high enrolment experienced before 2019 when World Food Program was withdrawn from schools.

Majority of families are experiencing harsh economic times since the on start of COVID19. At the time most jobs were lost and businesses closed down .As a result many livelihoods were lost. Majorly most parents are unable to pay school fees and feed their families. A crisis is looming where not every child will access education taking the country back to the years before 1983 when education was not free and subsidized.

In conclusion we request for any donation of food to our public schools until such a time when the Government of Kenya revives the food program, if you do so, we will see an influx of children in schools, reduced school dropouts, improved access to education, better academic results and all these will bring about the long term gains of education.

Finally as an office we request for a desk and a chair donation for our officers. A 1.2metres desk is 30,000ksh and an office chair is 15,000ksh.
