**Planned Projects - Beginning March 2026 Tentatively**

1. **Scholarships and Bursaries:** We aim to provide financial assistance to underprivileged students, enabling them to access quality education without financial barriers.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

Scholarships/Bursaries to Financial challenged – Parents to apply with proof of income (minimal to be determined)

Awards to excelling academically/Gifted Students: Based on academic performance and/ or participation in extracurricular activities.

Conditions: For awards to be based on academic performance or participation in extracurricular activities.

For financial aid to be approved following completed application by guardians of wards

2. **Extracurricular Projects:** We also aim to support various extracurricular activities that foster students' talents and skills beyond the classroom, including arts, sports, and community service projects.

3. **Upgrading Facilities:** We plan to upgrade the **school's computer labs** and libraries in its two locations at Asokwa and Buokrom with the latest technology and improve

the **playgrounds and classroom** to provide a safe and engaging environment for both classroom and recreational activities. We also plan to establish a **science laboratory** at the school to enhance students' understanding of scientific concepts and support them in pursuing their professional aspirations in this field.

4. **A school bus:** We plan to upgrade the school's bus to a better model and provide shuttle service between the two campuses, Asokwa and Buokrom at no cost to students and educators alike. This will undoubtedly enhance the convenience and accessibility for students and educators, allowing them to engage in various activities seamlessly.
5. **Financial Aid for staff:** We aim to support financially challenged educators

**Objective:** To support financially challenged educators by providing rent allowance, transport allowance, and loans to enhance their well-being.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

To provide the following for challenged staff:

- a. **Rent Allowance:** Educators living at least 16 kilometers away from the school.

**Details:** Amount of allowance: Up to 30% of monthly rent.

Conditions: Proof of residence and rental agreement required.

- b. **Transport Allowance:** For Educators commuting from 16 kilometers or more.

**Details:** Amount: Up to Ghc100 per month.

Conditions: Proof of residence, Valid transport receipts or fuel expenses documentation required.

- c. **Loans for Well-being:** Available to staff who have completed a minimum of two years of service at the school, have demonstrated satisfactory performance, and have **no documented breaches of duties or obligations** under the standards of conduct established by MISKL or ADMF.

**Details:** Types of loans to be granted: Personal loans, emergency loans.

Amount: Up to Ghc 5,000. With Interest Rate: 5% per annum.

Repayment Term: Up to 24 months.

Conditions: Minimum 2 years of service, satisfactory performance reviews.

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
